If you need some child-free time to catch up on appointments or jobs at home, don't hesitate to give us a call.

When does Occasional Care open?

Tresillian's Occasional Care Service is open 9.30 am - 2.15 pm Wednesday, Thursday and Fridays.

What do I need to bring?

- Baby's bottle-feed and solids. (Please label everything clearly with your child's name)
- A full change of clothes for baby including bibs and a face washer
- Cooled boiled water for baby, for between meals
- Spare nappies and a plastic bag for soiled nappies
- Eating utensils for baby



What if my baby has special needs?

Any special instructions regarding baby should be given when you arrive.

Breastfeeding

You're also welcome to breastfeed your baby at the Centre before you leave.

Bookings

Bookings can be made on (02) 9432 4000 up to two weeks in advance for a maximum of one day per week

Cost

\$44 Registration fee
 \$55 per child or \$77 for twins, per visit
 While this service is an extension of the Tresillian Day Stay Clinic it does not receive any Government subsidy.

How can payment be made?

Cheque (payable to Tresillian Occasional Care)
 or Cash (no change given)
 Tresillian does not accept credit cards.

Late Fee: Please note that Parents arriving after 2.30 pm to collect a child will be charged a \$20 fee. GST is included in charges.

Cancellations

Bookings not cancelled 24 hours in advance will be payable in full unless a doctor's certificate is provided. Children should arrive at the Centre no later than 10 am.

If you are running late please let us know by calling (02) 9432 4015. Staff reserve the right to cancel a booking should an emergency case arise. Every effort will be made to give reasonable notification.

What if My Baby is Sick?

Due to infection control, if your child is ill, or has an infectious disease for example measles, heavy colds etc they are not able to attend our Occasional Care Service. This is for the safety of all the children in the Centre. If you are unsure, please call and check with staff prior to coming in. If your child is requiring Panadol then he/she should not attend Occasional Care. Panadol and antibiotics will not be given by staff.

And, if I need help from Tresillian?

Our Nursing Staff and Social Workers can offer you advice and support at our Day Stay Clinic on the first floor. A referral is necessary, either from your Child and Family Health Centre or your local doctor.
